

ATHLETE DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

The purpose of the Athlete Development Committee (ADC) is to ensure that Biathlon BC programs are tailored to promote the development of BC athletes from the club level towards the national team level.

Athlete Development Committee Structure

- The chair of the committee is the Vice President Programs
- The Biathlon BC Provincial Head Coach
- 2-4 additional members appointed by the board
 - Members must be registered with Biathlon BC and must be NCCP Competition-Introduction certified biathlon coaches
 - Members will serve a one-year term which expires at the Biathlon BC Annual General Meeting

Responsibilities of the Athlete Development Committee

- Provide input in the development and final approval of the BC Athletes Manual as prepared by the Provincial Head Coach.
- Maintain and approve the CSI Targeted Athlete Criteria as prepared by the Provincial Head Coach.
- Approve the final selection of all BC Squad athletes or special event teams (i.e. Canada Winter Games, Competitive Tours etc.).
- Approve the final selection of the CSI Targeted Athletes list.
- Maintain an active database on the performance metrics of BC athletes for the purpose of ranking athletes and selecting squads. This database is to be published following each BC Cup.
- Liaise with the Provincial Head Coach on the implementation on provincial team programming.
- Liaise with the Technical Director and Officials committee to maintain the Biathlon BC Hosting Policy.
- Schedule Biathlon BC sanctioned events to ensure they promote athlete development and regional balance.
- Liaise with the Office-Administrator on the logistical planning for Biathlon BC Squad Activities.
 - The Provincial Head Coach, with assistance from the ADC, will be responsible for planning all training activities and recruiting coaching/technical staff for squad activities.
 - The Operations Manager will be responsible for planning the logistics surrounding travel, accommodations, meals and ground transportation at the site of squad activities under the direction of Provincial Head Coach.
- Administer athlete grant programs.
