



Up to \$500 REFUND for NCCP MULTI-SPORT MODULES

Biathlon BC is supporting the development of coaches by providing grants of up to \$500 towards the cost of NCCP multi-sport modules required for Community, Competition-Introduction, or Competition-Development certification.

In order to receive funding under this grant program, you must be a registered member with Biathlon BC for the 2020-2021 season, and the multi-sport modules must be completed between May 1, 2020 and January 31, 2021.

Grant funding is available for the following multi-sport modules:

Community Coach Modules

Trained Silver Community coaches or trained or certified Gold Community coaches
Coaches can apply for a grant to help fund the following module:

Competition Introduction Modules

In-training, Trained or Certified Competition-Introduction Coaches can apply for a grant to help fund the following modules:

- Making Ethical Decisions
- Planning a Practice
- Teaching and Learning
- Design a Basic Sport Program
- Basic Mental Skills
- Nutrition

Competition Development Modules

Certified Competition-Introduction Coaches, or In-training Competition-Development Coaches can apply for grant to help fund the following modules:

- Coaching & Leading Effectively
- Prevention and Recovery
- Leading Drug-Free Sport
- Developing Athletic Abilities
- Psychology of Performance
- Managing Conflict

Grant Amounts

The amount of the grants awarded will depend on the number of applicants. \$500 is the maximum amount of the grant and applicants may receive less than the maximum amount even if they have completed modules that cost more than \$500.

Decisions on awarding grants will be made in February 2021 after all applications have been received.
