

Biathlon BC International Tour Grant 2021

Program Objectives:

Biathlon BC is proud to see its members race for Team Canada in international biathlon competitions. It is with great pleasure that we are able to financially support athletes who qualify and represent Canada on Biathlon Canada sanctioned competitive tours. BC athletes who are selected and attend Biathlon Canada tours will be eligible for a grant of \$765-\$2500. The final amount of the grant is dependant on the number of BC athletes who are selected and attend tours.

Administration of the Program

This grant is administered by the VP Programs for Biathlon BC (programs@biathlonbc.ca). All grant applications must be sent to this email address. Applications must be submitted **prior** to the departure date of your tour (with the exception of World Cup Tours 1 & 2). Grants will be awarded after the last Tour team is selected and final number of eligible athletes is determined.

Grant Eligibility

Athletes must meet the following criteria to be considered for a BiBC High Performance Grant:

1. Athlete is a member in good standing with Biathlon BC as of November 16th, 2020.
2. Athlete is selected by Biathlon Canada to race on a competitive tour as outlined in Biathlon Canada's [National Team Program](#). Athletes who qualify for multiple tours are only eligible for one grant.
3. Athlete must attend the tour for which they were selected. Grants are not awarded for declined or cancelled tours.
4. Athlete commits, when not in conflict with a Biathlon Canada tour, to competing at the 2021 Canadian National Biathlon Championships (or virtual championship event TBD) as a BC athlete representing a BC club.
5. Athlete commits to sending social media content to Biathlon BC (sponsorship@biathlonbc.ca) from their competitive tour.

3. World Cup Tour 3 (February 23-March 22, 2021)

5. Open European Championships Tour (January 7-February 21, 2021)
6. IBU Cup 6 (March 8-March 15, 2021)
7. Junior World Championships (February 21-March 8, 2021)
8. Youth World Championships Tour (February 21-March 8, 2021)

Requirement to Submit Social Media Content:

Recipients of the Biathlon BC Tour Grant are role models for young biathletes in British Columbia. In order to help inspire the next generation of BC biathletes, Tour Grant recipients are required to submit content related to their tour to Biathlon BC (direct all content to sponsorship@biathlonbc.ca). The expectation is to submit at least **one entry per week on tour**.

All submitted content must adhere to Biathlon BC's social media and sponsorship policies.

- Photos/videos of competition
- Photos/videos of training camps
- Photos/videos of team events
- Photos/videos of training venues
- Photos/videos of travel on competitive tours
