- 1. Call to order 7:01 p.m.

- 4. Old Business
  - 4.1. BC Gaming request regarding BiBC society structure. Kevin was in contact with Via Sport and is waiting for a response.
  - 4.2. Excellence Funding. Jess distributed summary of her meetings via email. Discussed timelines and evaluation criteria. The intake cycle for new applicants need further clarification. Aaron suggested we review previous evaluations with Via Sport and request an external audit from the agency that conducts the evaluations. Kevin will follow up to obtain a copy of BiBC's last evaluation from Via Sport.
