SOCIAL/AWARDS CEREMONY: Unfortunately, current Northern Health

restrictions limit indoor gatherings to 50 people so there will

not be a social event.

AWARDS: All competitors will receive a prize provided by one of our

sponsors. There will be a draw for prize selection.

DEADLINES:

Registration by name and category: All finalized Registrations, by Name and Category and full payments, are due by Thursday, January 20, 2022, at 23:59 through the zone4.ca site. No mailed, faxed, telephoned or in-person registrations will be accepted. No payments will be accepted in person, all payments need to be completed on-line (credit card only). All attendees must register though Zone 4 for contact tracing purposes including coaches, parents, and spectators.

ELIGIBILITY: All competitors must be **CURRENT** members of Biathlon BC or equivalent Provincial or State organization. All BC competitors must provide a valid Biathlon BC membership number on the entry form.

FACILITIES: A clubhouse with washrooms is located adjacent to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association trails. Due to COVID protocols we ask that the clubhouse is only used for emergencies and washroom access. While inside masks and social distancing are required. In addition there are two outhouses.

PARKING: There is limited parking adjacent to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association clubhouse. Over flow parking is available along Quail Drive (the access road to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association trails).

WAXING: Due to COVID protocols there will be no waxing inside the clubhouse. There will be ample designated outdoor spaces available with electric plug-ins.

Biathlon BC Wax Policy

The Biathlon BC June 2019 Wax Policy will be in effect. 100% Fluoro, High Fluoro (for example UHF and HF), Medium Fluoro, and similarly fluorinated glide waxes, powders, pucks, blocks, liquids and other applications are not permitted. Only Low Fluoro (for example LF and LF Race) and non-Fluorinated glide waxes, powders, pucks, blocks, liquids and other applications are permitted. The use of hand structure on skis is permitted.

Adherence to this policy is self-governed and is the responsibility of coaches, athletes, parents, and wax technicians.

WARM UP/WAX TESTING: A warm up area will be available in the vicinity of the start.

CONCESSION: No lunch will be provided.

DIRECTION TO NVSA GROUNDS 3501 Quail Rd.

From the West: From Highway 16, take the first left after weigh scales (Hwy 27 Jct.) onto Redmond Pit Road and follow the signs.

From the East: From Highway 16, At 6 km West of Vanderhoof, turn right onto Redmond Pit Road and follow the signs.

RULES: IBU Rules and Regulations except where modified by the Biathlon Canada & Biathlon BC hosting policies and the Biathlon BC regional race guidelines for clubs. This is a low pressure fun event. Penalty loops will be governed by the honor system. Coaches will be asked to reset targets.

CANCELLATION: There are no refunds of any kind once a competitor registers and then subsequently withdraws from the competition or event or does not show up for the competition.

If the organizers are required to cancel the competition or event due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, then full refunds will be issued with the exception of any online processing fees.
