## 1.3 Rifle Import Regulations

Teams and individual competitors from outside of Canada must declare their rifles at the Canadian border, complete the necessary documentation, and pay the required fees when bringing rifles and ammunition into Canada. All athletes must register their own rifles and pay the applicable fee. Refer to the RCMP Firearms Program to obtain a Non-Resident Firearms Declaration: <a href="https://www.cbsa-asfc.gc.ca/import/iefw-iefa-eng.html">https://www.cbsa-asfc.gc.ca/import/iefw-iefa-eng.html</a> for guidelines.

#### **Notice regarding firearms:**

**Biathlon rifles are not permitted in the main lodge**. Competitors are required to transport their rifles from the parking lot to the biathlon range in either a soft or hard case. All Canadian athletes who are carrying their rifles on course must have in their possession, and be able to show upon request, their Possession and Acquisition Licence or Minor's Permit. Rifles should not be left unattended.

#### 1.4 Rules

International Biathlon Union (IBU) rules and regulations shall apply as fully as possible to all classes. The North American Hosting Policy shall apply to the IBU classes. Specific rules for classes not covered in IBU rules contained in the Biathlon BC Hosting Policy shall apply to those classes.

#### 1.5 Eligibility to Enter

All athletes participating must be registered participants with Biathlon Canada or USA Biathlon or another IBU national federation for the 2024-2025 season.

Biathlon BC members in good standing are eligible to receive full benefit of results in Biathlon BC programs, such as BC Cup points and team or squad selections.

## 2.3 Entry Fees and Registration

\$45.00 per athlete per competition

All individuals who wish to attend, including athletes and coaches, must register in advance. Registration will open on Zone4 on Monday, October 28, 2024 and will close at 23:59 Pacific Time on Sunday, December 1, 2024. Register through the Zone4 registration link <u>HERE</u>. Payment must be made using a credit card. No entries will be accepted after this time.

#### 2.4 Cancellation Policy

There are no refunds if a competitor does not show up for the competition. Zone4 processing fees will not be refunded for any reason. If a competitor withdraws at least one week prior to the event (by 23:59 on December 6, 2024) they will be refunded less an administration fee of \$10 per competition.

If the event is cancelled one week ahead (before December 6, 2024) the registration fees will be refunded in full. If unforeseen circumstances cause cancellation closer to the event, the organizers may retain entry fees sufficient to ensure no loss against monies already spent.

If the event is cancelled on the competition weekend due to severe cold weather or force majeure, no refund of registration fees will be made.
