Biathlon BC and Biathlon Alberta have designated Odlum Brown BC Cup #1 as a Western Series event for the 2025/26 season. Aimed at bringing the strongest and deepest fields together in Western Canada, the Western Series will feature the best biathletes the west has to offer. The Western Series will consist of two Biathlon Alberta events and two Biathlon BC events, with a season-long points race and prize money up for grabs in the Senior B/G, Youth M/W, Junior M/W, and Senior M/W categories.

1 General Information

1.1 Competition Venue

Sovereign Lake Nordic Centre, Vernon, BC. The facility is located 22 km east of Vernon within Silver Star Provincial Park. Located off Silver Star Road, just 2 km west of Silverstar Mountain Resort.

The Competition Office is located in the Biathlon Cabin beside the Range and will be open from 08:00 - 16:00 on December 5, 6, 7, 2025.

1.3 Rifle Import Regulations

Teams and individual competitors from outside of Canada must declare their rifles at the Canadian border, complete the necessary documentation, and pay the required fees when bringing rifles and ammunition into Canada. All athletes must register their own rifles and pay the applicable fee. Refer to the RCMP Firearms Program to obtain a [Non-Resident Firearms Declaration](#) for guidelines.

Biathlon rifles are not permitted in the Day Lodge. Competitors are required to transport their rifles from the parking lot to the biathlon range in either a soft or hard case. All Canadian athletes who are carrying their rifles on course must have in their possession, and be able to show upon request, their Possession and Acquisition Licence or Minor's Permit. Rifles may not be left unattended.

1.4 Rules

International Biathlon Union (IBU) rules and regulations shall apply as fully as possible to all classes. The North American Hosting Policy shall apply to the IBU classes. Specific rules for classes not covered in IBU rules contained in the Biathlon BC Hosting Policy shall apply to those classes.

1.5 Eligibility to Enter

All athletes participating must be registered participants with [Biathlon Canada](#) or [USA Biathlon](#) or another IBU national federation for the 2025-2026 season.

Biathlon BC members in good standing are eligible to receive full benefit of results in Biathlon BC programs, such as BC Cup points and team or squad selections.

2.1 Competition Events

Sunday, December 7, 2025 - **SPRINT**

2.2 Classes of Competition

The following classes of competition will be run, depending on sufficient entries. Classes with fewer than 3 registrants may be combined with another class.

Penalty loop distances: 150m for Men/Women, Jr Men/Women, Youth Men/Women;
75m for U17 Boys/Girls, Development 1 & 2, Adult 1- 4, Para, and U11

2.3 Entry Fees and Registration

All registration will be done through [Zone4](#). Registration will open October 29th, 2025 and will close at 23:59 Pacific Time on Wednesday, November 26th, 2025. Payment must be made by credit card.

\$45 per athlete per competition - All .22 Rifle Categories

\$35 per athlete per competition - All Electronic Rifle Categories

All registered members of Biathlon Canada or US Biathlon are eligible to compete in the classes as stipulated in this invitation. Electronic Rifle only athletes may compete with a [Recreational Membership](#).

2.4 Cancellation Policy

There are no refunds if a competitor does not show up for the competition. Zone4 processing fees will not be refunded for any reason. If a competitor withdraws prior to registration closing (by 23:59 on November 26, 2025) they will be refunded their registration fee of \$10 per competition day. If withdrawal is made after registration closing, there will be no refunds.

In the event of event cancellation (other than due to "day of" weather), a refund of registration fees less administration and event expenses already incurred will be provided. There will be no refunds for cancellation due to "day of" weather.

2.5 Trail Passes

Trail and Range passes are included for Official Training and Competition Days. Passes must be purchased for any use of the trails on any day outside of the Official Training and Competition days. Tickets can be purchased online through the Sovereign Lake [webstore](#) or in person at the Day Lodge. Sovereign Lake Nordic Club reserves the right to remove athletes from events (without refund) if they are discovered skiing at Sovereign without a trail pass.

Zeroing lanes will be assigned by draw based on how many athletes they have competing, with no priority to any team or club. If you will be zeroing with another Club/Training Centre other than your affiliated club, please indicate this on your Zone4 registration.

7 Wax Protocol - only for Biathlon Canada Selection Categories

If this event serves as a nomination event for Biathlon Canada, a wax protocol will be implemented for competitors in the Men, Junior Men, Women, and Junior Women classes. More information to follow.

8 Awards & Banquet

North American Cup Medals will be awarded to the top 3 competitors in each of the following IBU categories: Men/Women, Junior Men/Women and Youth Women/Men.

Biathlon BC Medals will be awarded to the top 3 competitors in the following male and female BC Cup categories: U17 Standing and U17 Prone Categories

Sovereign Lake Nordic Club Medals will be awarded to top 3 competitors in the following male and female BC Cup categories:

- Adult 1- 4 (.22 and Electronic, irrespective of age)
- Development 1 & 2 (.22 and Electronic, irrespective of age)
- Para (.22 and Electronic, irrespective of age)

The Individual Competition medal presentation will be awarded after dinner at the Banquet.
