COMPETITION VENUE:

Whistler Olympic Park hosted the Nordic events for the 2010 Winter Olympic Games. The biathlon stadium features 30 electronic HoRa targets, with covered canopy and lights. The trails are open with natural snow from mid-November until mid-April. There are fourteen on-trail wax cabins within 100 meters of the range. The range is at 870 meters elevation. The highest point on the course is at 890 m elevation, and the lowest point is at 849 m elevation.

Whistler Olympic Park is located 16 km south of Whistler and 40 km north of Squamish on Highway 99, then 9 km West on Callaghan Valley Road. Once inside the park, follow the signs to the biathlon stadium at the end of Callaghan Road.

Course maps and stadium diagrams are available on the Sea to Sky Nordics website.

The day lodge is located 1 km from the biathlon range, just up the stairs from parking lots 1 and 2. It includes the following amenities:

ENTRY FEES:

\$45.00 per athlete per BC Cup competition

\$35.00 per athlete per competition in the U11, Dev1, or Dev1 Ecoaims categories

All registered members of Biathlon Canada or US Biathlon are eligible to compete in the classes as stipulated in this invitation. Optical Ecoaim-only athletes may compete with a [Recreation Membership](#).

Adult Category Recommendations:

Adult 4 - for Expert skiers, ex-National Team members, etc

Adult 3 - for Strong skiers

Adult 2 - for Intermediate skiers and recommended for anyone 65+

Adult 1 - (non-carry, optical rifles, prone only) for new biathletes and/or novice skiers

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Note: If you can no longer race due to the location change, please let us know before January 31st. Refunds will be issued as soon as possible after the event.

There are no refunds if a competitor does not show up for the competition. Zone 4 processing fees will not be refunded for any reason.

If a competitor withdraws at least one week prior to the event (by January 30th, 2026) they will be refunded less an administration fee of \$10 per Competition. If the event is cancelled one week ahead (before January 30th, 2026) then the registration fees will be refunded in full. If unforeseen circumstances cause cancellation closer to the event, the organizers may retain entry fees sufficient to ensure no loss against monies already spent.

TRAIL PASSES:

Trail pass requirements must be confirmed on the registration form. Trail passes for registered athletes, coaches, and volunteers will be available for pick-up at the Whistler Olympic Park gate kiosk starting on Thursday 5th February, 2026.

Parents/guardians dropping participants off for competitions must also purchase a day ticket (online or in person) or present a season pass if they plan to ski or snowshoe. If parent/guardians are not skiing or snowshoeing, or only dropping off they do not need a day ticket or season pass.

Pets are not allowed in the competition area or trails near the biathlon stadium.

Will be included in the fees for **Saturday and Sunday only**. Please purchase a trail pass for training, while registering on Zone4, if you intend to ski Friday.

Rules:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the current IBU Event and Competition Rules, and the [Biathlon BC August 2025 Hosting Policy](#). The [Biathlon BC Firearms Safety Policy](#) and no-fluoro wax policy (as outlined in the Biathlon BC Hosting Policy) will also be in effect.

Any competitor carrying a .22 cal rifle must have a current PAL or Minor's carrying permit.

RIFLE IMPORT REGULATIONS:

Teams and individual competitors from outside of Canada must declare their rifles at the Canadian border, complete the [necessary documentation](#), and pay the required fees when bringing rifles and ammunition into Canada.
